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Dubai 'O Plate' 2023 Sporting & Technical Regulations 2023 V1

REGULATIONS

The final text of these Sporting Regulations shall be the English version, which will be used, should any dispute arise as to their interpretation. Headings in this document are for ease of reference only and do not form part of the regulations.

The 2023 Dubai O Plate event will be run in accordance with FIA International Sporting Code (the "Code") and its appendices, FIA and CIK-FIA official Bulletins, CIK-FIA Technical Regulations, General Prescriptions applicable to CIK-FIA Karting International Events, UAE RMC Technical Regulations 2022/2023, Dubai Bambino Cup Regulations 2022/23, EMSO National Sporting Code and the 2023 Dubai O plate Supplementary & Technical Regulations of the Event and any further written instructions that the organizers may issue for the event. There are some differences herewith compared to the UAE ROTAX National Series, so please read carefully.

1 – GENERAL:

The Kartdrome will organize The Dubai 'O Plate', as a one-off event. The event will be held over two days, the **21st and 22nd of January 2023** and following information will be posted on: <https://www.dubaiautodrome.ae/kartdrome-main/racing/dubai-o-plate-race-weekend/>

This event will be organized and administrated by Dubai Autodrome / Kartdrome in accordance with the Emirates Motorsports Organisation (EMSO) and the UAE RMC Technical regulations. **ANYTHING WHICH IS NOT EXPRESSLY ALLOWED IS FORBIDDEN.**

2 – INFORMATION SPECIFIC TO THE EVENTS:

2.2 - ENTRIES:

Entry consists of:

- Holding a valid FIA Competition Kart License **as per Regulation 2.3**
- Filling the entry form and paying the event entry fee at the Kartdrome reception or;
- Entering and paying online: <https://www.dubaiautodrome.ae/kartdrome-main/racing/dubai-o-plate-race-weekend/>
- All Entries must be submitted no later than the **January 5th 2023 before 11pm**. Any entries received after this, will be declared a '**late entry**' & the organizer have a right to refuse entries submitted after this deadline.
- b. Any entry not accompanied by the fee shall be null and void.
- c. Entries will be 100% secured only once entrants have received an email of confirmation.

2.3 – COMPETITION REQUIREMENTS:

2.3.1 – Kart Licence:

- A. Drivers must be in possession of a **valid National or International Kart Licence issued either by EMSO or the ASN of another country**. If the Entrant is other than the driver then the entrant must hold a separate valid Entrant Licence issued by EMSO or the ASN of another country.
- B. **All competitors holding a licence issued outside UAE** must gain "Start Permission" from their licence-issuing ASN. All physical competition licences must be surrendered at signing on (along with the start permission paperwork if applicable) for verification. Failure to produce the required documentation will result in enforced non-participation.

2.4.3 – Fees (all prices below are inclusive of VAT TAX) :

- a. **Entry fee:** will be **1,250 AED** for all ROTAX class entrants for the event.
- b. ****Special Early Bird Entry fee of just 999 aed** for all ROTAX entries received **BEFORE 11pm** on **January 5th 2023**
- c. **Bambino Cup Entry fee:** will be **399 AED**. (Bambino is to be held over just the 1 day)
- d. **Friday Practice Fees:** Bambinos: **170 AED**, Platinum Members: **195 AED** & Gold/Silver Members: **395AED**. (silver membership of **150 AED** mandatory for local drivers)
- e. **Transponder fee for Bambino only :** will be **105 AED**
Transponder fee for two days hire: will be **210 AED**
- f. **Lap Time Print Out for whole event fee:** will be **30 AED** (can be collected from Reception)

2.4.4 – Entry Refund:

Race entries once paid cannot be refunded after the deadline of **January 5th 2023**. In case of genuine reason subject to Race directors' approval, an admin fee of 210 aed will be deducted from the payment.

2.5 – EVENTS FORMAT:

Each Rotax class event consists of:

- **Friday the 20th of January 2023** – Official Practice & Technical Scrutineering

- Sign-on

- **Saturday the 21st of January 2023:**

- Sign on for drivers who didn't sign on Friday

- Drivers briefing

- Practice & Qualifying combined

- **Heat 1**

- **Heat 2**

- **Heat 3**

- **Sunday the 22nd of January 2023:**

- **Warm up**

- **Super Heat**

- **Grand Final**

- Award presentation

2.5.1 – Signing on:

All drivers will have to sign the disclaimer form before the start of the event. Sign on will happen at the beginning of the day and drivers will be required to provide and surrender their FIA license. Any foreign CIK licenses issued outside the UAE must have their ASN Start Permission approval for the event.

2.5.2 – Drivers briefing:

Driver's briefing is mandatory; please refer to each event time table for specific timing. Drivers showing up late or not attending the driver's briefing will be fined **210 AED with vat** and potentially might not be allowed to participate in the event. Participation will be subject to clerk of the course approval. In case of the clerk of the course not allowing a late driver to participate, the driver's entry fee will not be reimbursed. All fines will be forwarded to EMSO.

Kindly note: All Fines must be paid in Cash. Credit Cards will not be accepted.

2.5.3 – Scrutineering

All Driver's must have scrutineered during the allocated time period detailed on the official time schedule, on **Friday the 20th of January 2023**.

2.5.4 – STARTERS

The maximum number of starters for each race will be that set by the organisers, subject to the limits set by the Track Licence and the Codes. The minimum is 6 per class. The maximum for each practice session will be the Track Licence figure plus 20%. Should any of the minimum figures not be reached the organisers reserve the right to cancel the race, amalgamate classes or run alternative competitive or non-competitive track activities for the classes as appropriate.

2.5.5 – Pre-Grid Gate Closing

All Competitors must arrive to the Pre-Grid Gate (next to fuel control area) **5 minutes** before the Official Start time of **Practice-Qualifying, Heats, Super Heat & Grand Final**. After which point, the Pre-Grid gate will be closed and any Competitor arriving to the Pre-Grid after this time will not be permitted to Start the race, without the permission of the Clerk of the Course. Should the Clerk of the course give permission, the Competitor must start at the back of the Grid.

Under no circumstance will Competitors be allowed to join the grid once the Formation Lap has started.

The Official Time will be as per the time displayed on the Official Timing Screen.

3. TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

3.1 - BAMBINO REGULATIONS:

This category will be organized and administrated by Dubai Autodrome / Kartdrome in accordance with the 2022-2023 **Dubai Bambino Cup Regulations** found: www.dubaiautodrome.com/bambino-cup with the following 'exceptions':

- Drivers who are 5 years old on the day of the O Plate, may compete, including those who are aged 8 years of age on the day of the event.
- Fixed gearing on the rear of 85 sprocket for for both COMER & IAME Bambino Classes.
- All Bambino Cup Drivers must have driving Experience prior to the event.
- Weight limit for driver & kart must be as follows:
Comer powered karts = 69kg
IAME powered karts = 77kg
- Tyres: **Comer** powered Bambinos must use the **Mojo C2**
IAME powered Bambinos must use the **Komet K1D-M.**

3.2 – UAE ROTAX MAX REGULATIONS

In conjunction and with the approval of the UAE Rotax Max Challenge, we will be following the **2022/23 UAE RMC Sporting Regulations & Technical Regulations, with the following exceptions:**

- All engines & carburetors will be scrutineered at the request of chief scrutineer and any engine or carburetor, may be subjected to being bagged, sealed and sent to Rotax Headquarters or designated representative for internal inspection to confirm conformity.
- Visors: Tinted Visors may not be used after sunset. Drivers wearing tinted visors may not be released from the dummy grid if sunset has occurred. This will be communicated through the Clerk of the course.
- All Competitors must comply to **article 7** – listed below

3.3 - The number **0** can be used by the reigning Class of **2022 O Plate Champion**, during the O Plate event hosted by the DAMC, for that same category. All further Number requests must be confirmed by series organisers - DAMC for the O Plate event.

Dubai-O-Plate 2023 Winners may carry the 'O' Plate within UAE Rotax MAX Challenge series for the remainder of the 2023/24 season and up until the following edition of the Dubai O Plate, providing the same category is retained."

3.4 - Fuel:

- Control Fuel & Oil:** Only the fuel & the lubricating Oil purchased from Dubai Kartdrome is permitted to be used during the event for all ROTAX & Bambino Classes.
- ROTAX CLASSES** - Only this control fuel is permitted for the duration of the event and will be kept within Fuel Parc Ferme.
- BAMBINO CLASSES** – Only this control fuel is permitted for the duration of the event. Competitors can keep the fuel with them.
- For Bambino & ROTAX categories:** Should the Organisers opt not to run control fuel (to be notified via SR's), then all fuel must be Unleaded and that which is readily available at a [UAE Roadside petrol station](#). No additives or performance enhancing substances are allowed.

3.5 Overflow Bottles:

For all **ROTAX Categories**, all karts must have an overflow bottle for the fuel tank, the Radiator and Oil breather pipes. Pipes must be connected to the bottle securely. Bambino's however, do not require overflow bottles. Oil breather pipes & radiator overflow pipes may share the same Overflow bottle.

3.6.1 - Tyres:

All tyres to be used for both [Official Practice](#) on Friday and the [Dubai O Plate event](#) – must be purchased from Dubai Kartdrome reception.

3.6.2 - Tyre Marking: Tyre marking will be done by the official tyre suppliers, **ROTAX UAE**, during tyre handout.

3.6.3 - Tyre Allocation:

- Each Rotax Category Participant will receive **6 tyres (Mandatory)**
1 x Complete set of tyres (2 x front and 2 x rear)
1 x Front Tyre
1 x Rear Tyre

3.6.4 - Warm up Practice Tyres:

Official Marked tyres must be used in all sessions of the event, with the sole exception of warm-up (Sunday) when competitors may use either marked or non marked tyres as long as they conform with the class of the technical regulations.

3.7 177 MAX Class - Technical regulations as per Senior Max, with the following exceptions:

- Minimum weight of Driver & Kart = **177kg**
- Driver's must weigh a Minimum of **85kg** with helmet, suit and race gear.
- Minimum age of driver needs to **15yrs** on the day of the event
- 177 Max will run on the same grid as Senior Max.
177 Max Starting positions will be based on the official overall qualifying results when combined with Senior Max
- 177 Max kart numbers will be based on first come, first served. Number selection between 602 – 699
- 177 Max drivers will be classified overall in the results when mixed with seniors. The top 3 highest placed 177 Max drivers from the overall standings will be awarded on the podium

4.0 - Number Plates & Numbering:

- Yellow Background and black numbers as per ROTAX UAE Regulations

4.1 - STARTING PROCEDURES:

All Rotax Categories : Rolling Start

Bambino Category (lame & Comer): 5 second interval gaps when released from dummy grid

5.0 FORMAT FOR ROTAX Categories (except Bambino)

- 7 minute Practice & Qualifying combined (Saturday only)
- 5 minute Warm up Practice (Sunday only)
- 3 x race heats of laps as prescribed in the official timetable
- Starting positions for each of the three heats is based on your qualifying position overall
- Points will be awarded for each heat as per finishing order, as per the Points Scoring table detailed in Regulation 5.1
- After the three heats, a total point tally will be made up to determine the starting positions for the SUPER HEAT
- Points from the Super heat + the total points accumulated across the three heats, will be used to determine the starting positions for the Grand Final
- The official classified results from the Grand Final, will decide who is the **2023 O Plate Champion** and official final finishing order

5.1.1 TIE ON POINTS: Should there be any drivers tied on points at the conclusion of the heats & Superheat ("ref" to 5.0 – g), Grid positions will be determined by the Classified result from the **Super Heat**.

5.2 - BAMBINO FORMAT:

- 3 x time trials of 10 minutes in duration.
 - Each kart is released at 5 to 10 second interval gaps from pit exit.
 - The order in which the karts are released for each time trial, will be dictated according to the computer-generated system.
 - Points will be awarded, as per the Dubai O Plate points system as shown in Regulation 5.1, according to the overall classified results of each time trial.
 - The Bambino winner is dictated by the driver with the highest scores in their Category, after the completion of all three time trials on the day.
- * In the event there is a tie-on points – result will be declared as per which driver set the fastest lap set during any one of the 3 time trials.
- The Dubai O Plate Bambino format will be held over just the one day (**January 21st - 2023**)
 - Parents/Mechanics who are on track as a 'pusher' are prohibited from: Following Live Timing on their phone, coaching or timing their drivers
 - Organizers will run both COMER C50 & IAME 1M engines during the same time trial.
 - Comer and IAME Categories will be scored separately**
 - Dubai Bambino Cup Championship points will be awarded based on the Overall Classified results from the Dubai O Plate event

6.0 Transponder & Lap Time Print outs:

6.1 Transponder hire - Entrants who don't own their own one, can arrange to buy or hire for one from the Dubai Kartdrome reception. Hire charge for the weekend will be 105AED (inclusive of VAT TAX) for Bambinos and 210AED for all other classes. Please contact Purie: purificacaop@dubaiautodrome.com to reserve one for you.

6.2 Lap time print outs – Lap time print outs will be charged 30 AED (inclusive of VAT TAX) for the full race event.

*Kindly remember to return the Transponders on Saturday evening, so that we can put them on charge overnight, ready for Sunday's event.

7.0 - ADVERTISING ON KARTS, OVERALLS AND HELMETS

Competitors in all categories, will be required to put a Dubai Autodrome visors strip on their helmets and on the front nose cone of their kart. These stickers will have to be requested from the organisers. Competitors without a Dubai Autodrome visor strip on their helmets, will not be allowed to exit from the dummy grid.

8.0 – PRIZES

8.1 - The 2023 Dubai 'O Plate' will take place at the Dubai Kartdrome. The winner of their respective categories, will be crowned: **Dubai O plate Champions** for 2023. There will be prizes given and awarded to drivers in certain categories, according to their official classified results. In such cases, competitors must confirm the utilization of the prize within 2 months. Failure to do so, then O Plate Organisers will reassign the prize at their discretion.

8.2 - Should any prize winner not wish to utilize 'themselves' any prize they have won, they are to inform Dubai Autodrome Management, who will reassign the prize at their discretion. There will be no cash replacement for the said prize and prizes can not be given away.

8.3 - Should any Prize winner have won a race weekend. The prize winner is requested to book their race weekend with either of the O plate Sponsors mentioned, by April 30th 2023. Dubai Autodrome Management, reserve the right will reassign prizes at their discretion.

8.4 - Should any Prize Winner have booked their race weekend with either of the sponsors mentioned, but cancel it or not turn up for the event – Prize becomes automatically 'null & void' and Dubai Autodrome Management, reserve the right to award the said prize to the next highest competitor.

8.5 – RMC International Trophy tickets will be issued to the Winners of:

Junior MAX
Senior MAX
DD2
DD2 Masters

8.5.1 - Dubai O Plate and their partner Rotax UAE will award the Winner of which ever of the below two categories has the 'largest number of entries' for the 2023 Dubai O Plate:-

- **Micro MAX**
- **Mini MAX**

8.5.2 – There will be no RMC International Trophy Ticket awarded to the Winner of 177 Max – as this category isn't run at the International Trophy.

8.5.3 - These Finals Tickets are not transferable. If for any reason a winner can not attend the RMC International Trophy, the Dubai O Plate Organisers will reassign tickets at their discretion.

8.6 – Bambino Prize – A ROTAX MICRO engine will be awarded to the highest placed finisher UAE/GCC Resident in the COMER Class, subject to:

8.6.1 – The prize winner will be old enough to race Micro Max in the 2023/24 UAE RMC Season

8.6.2 - The prize winner subscribing to the 2023/24 UAE RMC Season

8.6.3 - The winner agrees that engine will not be sold on locally or exported from the UAE. Should the winner fail to agree on this term, then the engine will be awarded to the next highest placed Comer Class finisher and so on.

9.0 - Floor Mats:

The use of floor mats (or suitable equivalent floor covering) beneath karts when work is being carried out is mandatory throughout practice and race days. This prevents problematic, unsightly and costly tarnishing of paddock areas belonging to the host venue. The organisers reserve the right to eject from the paddock area any competitor who fails to observe this ruling and/or may insist that the offender purchase/hire appropriate floor protection if immediately available.

10.1 - VENUE REQUIREMENT: It is absolutely forbidden to disrupt the paddock, car park or venue ground surfaces in any way by marking, drilling, staining etc. It is required that all competitors comply with instructions issued by representatives of the venue as well as the organisation.

10.2 – NO DOGS OR PETS ALLOWED : Dogs & Pets are not permitted at the Kartdrome at anytime.

10.3 – NO SMOKING PERMITTED – Dubai Kartdrome is a non-smoking Venue. Smoking & Vaping/electronic cigarettes is not permitted within the Green Fence boundary confines of the Kartdrome, including the viewing terrace, at anytime.

11.0 – TRACK ACCESS: Please note that the track has restricted access and is out of bounds to all personnel other than:

- Competitors
- Officials
- Authorized Media
- Bambino Track Side Assistants (when appropriate)

In the event of a serious incident / Red Flag situation, the clerk of the course may elect to have a parent, guardian or team member of the driver (s) involved to be escorted to the scene, when the situation has been brought under control and it is safe to do so. No other unauthorised personnel are to be permitted to enter the track during an incident.

12.1 – CLARIFICATION ON OVERTAKING UNDER THE YELLOW FLAG:

This is self-explanatory and is when a driver fails to observe the requirements of this flag being displayed by race officials.

Overtaking under a yellow flag or full course yellow flag: Yellow flag conditions start from the Point at which the flag is being waved, ie Marshal post or where an official is standing whilst waving the yellow flag. You must have completed your overtake and be in front of the kart your overtaking, **before** the yellow flag is being waved. Should the overtake have taken place after the Marshal Post, a penalty may be applied. Once passing the Marshal Post, the driver can only start overtaking once passing a 'Green' flag or passing another manned marshal post not waving the yellow.

12.2.1 – CLARIFICATION ON REGAINING YOUR ORIGINAL POSITION ON A FORMATION LAP: (For all categories except Bambino):

A driver who is otherwise delayed and finds themselves out of position will have the possibility of regaining his/her place, as long as it's done before the Red Formation Line. If a driver is unable to regain their original starting position – they can stay in the position they reached, provided it's not higher up the grid than their original. Eg. If the driver was meant to start P3 and dropped to P21 on the formation lap. If the driver manages to reach P7 before the Red Formation Line, then the driver can stay in the said position. In order to regain one's position, it is forbidden to use any course other than the track used during the race. Any driver permitted to join the track AFTER a false start MUST remain at the back of the grid on the current formation lap and any subsequent formation lap until the race is officially started.

12.2.2 – IF the Clerk of the Course considers that a Driver has been immobilized as a result of another Driver's mistake, the Clerk of the Course or the Race Director may stop the formation lap and start again the starting Procedure on the basis of the original grid or allow the impeded driver to regain their position.

12.3 – BLUE & RED FLAG (DOUBLE DIAGONAL):

When a Driver is shown this flag, the concerned Driver must return to Parc Ferme Immediately or on the next lap.

13.0 – DUBAI O PLATE WILL BE USING THE BELOW LIST OF PENALTIES FOR ROTAX CATEGORIES.

Although the above details are mandatory penalties for driving, behaviour etc. This does not preclude the Stewards issuing penalties against other breaches of regulations.

14 – OFFICIAL TESTING: All drivers who wish to participate within Official Testing, must have a Transponder Fitted and tyres must have been supplied by Dubai Kartdrome. Karts without a working Transponder will be shown the Technical Flag and must report to the Pit Lane.

15 - PADDOCK FEE: Dubai Kartdrome will charge all teams occupying any space within the designated paddock area, 5AED per square meter (Inclusive of VAT TAX). This fee covers teams for the official two day Race Weekend. There will be no charge for teams setting up on the Wednesday & Thursday. However, any teams wishing to set up prior to Wednesday the **18th of January 2023** - will be charged the above-mentioned fee. Teams or drivers wishing to use a pit box will be charged 525AED for the two-day event. Garages are limited, so please reserve your garage with Purie in advance, to avoid disappointment. Teams have to inform reception before setting up so correct location and space will be allocated by one of the staff and payment to be cleared on the first day of setup.
