

2024 RAMADAN CHALLENGE SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

DUBAI AUTODROME MOTOR SPORTS CLUB, PO Box 57331, Dubai, UAE will organise the 2024 Ramadan Challenge on the below dates;

Round 1 - 12th of March 2024 - The Drop

Round 2 - 19th of March 2024 - Monaco Switch Back Round 3 - 26th of April 2024 - Reverse Speedway Round 4 - 2nd of April 2024 - Reverse International

The Ramadan Challenge will be organized by the DAMC and will follow for all four rounds the 2024 Dubai Kartdrome Sodi World Series Sprint Races Sporting Regulations and the 2024 RAMADAN CHALLENGE SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS.

The final text of the Supplementary Regulations shall be the English version, which will be used in the case of any dispute arising as to their interpretation. Heading in this document are for ease and reference only and do not form part of these Supplementary Regulations.

Junior Cup, Senior Cup & Masters Rounds will be held at the Dubai Kartdrome Outdoor CIK Circuit, as per track layout specified above.

1. ENTRIES:

Early Bird Race Entries can be paid online www.dubaiautodrome.com or e-mail joelyny@dubaiautodrome.com or can be paid at Outdoor Reception 10 days prior to Round 1.

- 1.1 ENTRY CRITERIA: As per the Dubai Kartdrome Sodi World Series (SWS) 2024 Sprint Races Sporting Regulations 2.3.1, 2.3.2 & 2.3.3
- 1.2 PAYMENTS:

There is an 'early bird Entry fee' (for all four rounds & Early bird entries guarantee entry to all four rounds of the Ramadan Challenge)

Junior Cup Early Bird fee is AED 1680 per driver inc VAT

Senior Cup Early Bird fee is AED 1995 per driver inc VAT

1.3 All entries received after the <u>2nd of March</u> will be charged as follows:

Junior Cup AED 495 per round inc of 5% VAT Senior Cup AED 595 per round inc of 5% VAT

- **1.4** Early bird payments are non transferable and no refund will be given if no show.
- 1.5 No refunds or credit against future races will be given on the individual entries, for late comers or no show.
- 1.6 STARTERS: The maximum number of entries permitted per Ramadan Challenge Round is: 35 x Seniors and 29 x Juniors
- 1.7 The OFFICAL NOTICE BOARD will be displayed: Under the Canopy at the Outdoor Kartdrome
- 1.8 Time Schedule of Events: Timetable will be displayed on official Notice board and website.
- 2 FORMAT:
- 2.1 Junior Cup Format

Limited to 29 drivers entering

Practice & Qualifying - 8 minutes

- Race 1 --> (Drivers will start as as per their official classified Qualfiying result) Race Laps as stipulated on timetable
- Race 2 --> (Top 5 driver's from Race1 will have their start positions reversed)
- Race 3 --> (Top 10 driver's from Race2 will have their start positions reversed)

2.2 <u>Senior Cup & Masters Format:</u>

Limited to 35 drivers entering

Practice & Qualifying – 8 minutes

- Race 1 --> (Drivers will start as as per their official classified Qualfiying result) Race Laps as stipulated on timetable
- Race 2 --> (Top 5 driver's from Race1 will have their start positions reversed)
- Race 3 --> (Top 10 driver's from Race2 will have their start positions reversed)







- 3.0: POINT SCORING:
- 3.1: Event Point Scoring: The Organisers will keep track of each competitor's finishing results during each event, using the points system detailed in the 2024 Dubai Kartdrome Sodi World Series (SWS) Sprint Races Sporting Regulations, Regulation 2.4.2.9. Points from this point system will be awarded for each heat and tallied together. The Driver with the highest total of points, will be declared the Overal Winner of the day.

Tie On Points during a Race Event:

- > Should there be a situation where competitors are equal on points, then the classification will be decided by the Driver who had the highest finishings from any of the races during the event.
- > In the event there is still a draw, the result will be decided as per the official classified result from qualifying.
- **3.2:** <u>SWS World Ranking Points:</u> The Ramadan Challenge will count towards the SWS World Rankings and those drivers registered with the SWS World Series, their points will be allocated as per the point scoring system defined by the SodiWSeries regulations.

*For both Junior Cup, Senior Sprint Cup & Masters: THREE sets of SWS points will be forwarded to the official SWS Championship, as per the official classified results from each of the the races.

Ramadan Championship Points: Each Ramadan Challenge competitor will score "Ramadan Championship Points", to determine the overall Championship Ranking after 4 rounds. These points are listed in **SR. 3.4**

- There will be an additional *Ramadan Championship points* for the driver setting **Pole Position** during **Qualifying** and the **Fastest Lap** on the night, for both Junior Cup and Seniors, in all four Rounds.
- 3.6 <u>Tie On Points at the conclusion of the Ramadan Challenge</u>
 - In the case of 2 drivers are having the same number of Championship points, they will be separated with regards to the following elements: Number of 1st places, 2nd places, 3rd places and so as per rounds.

 Number of pole positions, 2nd places, 3rd places and so on in qualifying sessions.

- 4.0: PRIZES:
- 4.1 For each of the Ramadan Champions (Junior, Senior & Masters categories) they will receive a made to measure Dubai Kartdrome FIA Karting, courtesy of Dojo Designs.
- 4.2 **The 2024 Junior Ramadan Challenge Champion** will receive a <u>Free race entry</u> into either an IAME or Rotax Club event during the 2024 season courtesy of Dojomoto Racing. Please refer to the Terms and Conditions mention in **Regulation 5**.
- 4.3 The 2025 Senior Ramadan Challenge Champion will receive a Free test day in either an IAME or Rotax kart.
- 5.0 TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PRIZES:
- 5.1: Should any prize winner entitled one of the prizes awarded not wish to utilize them, they are to inform Dubai Autodrome Management, who will award the said prize to the next highest competitor.
