

2026 RAMADAN CHALLENGE SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

DUBAI AUTODROME MOTOR SPORTS CLUB, PO Box 57331, Dubai, UAE will organise the 2025 Ramadan Challenge on the below dates;

Round 1 - 23rd of February 2026- Reverse International
Round 2 - 2nd of March 2026 - Monaco
Round 3 - 9th of March 2026 - Reverse Hill
Round 4 - 16th of March 2026 - Switchback

The Ramadan Challenge will be organized by the DAMC and will follow for all four rounds the **2026 Dubai Kartdrome Sodi World Series Sprint Races Sporting Regulations and the 2026 RAMADAN CHALLENGE SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS**.

The final text of the Supplementary Regulations shall be the English version, which will be used in the case of any dispute arising as to their interpretation. Heading in this document are for ease and reference only and do not form part of these Supplementary Regulations.

Junior Cup, Senior Cup & Masters Rounds will be held at the Dubai Kartdrome Outdoor CIK-FIA Circuit, as per track layout specified above.

1. **ENTRIES:**
Early Bird Race Entries can be paid online www.dubaiautodrome.com or e-mail vaalb@dubaiautodrome.com or can be paid at Outdoor Reception **on or before 16th February 2026.**
- 1.1 **ENTRY CRITERIA:** As per the Dubai Kartdrome Sodi World Series (SWS) 2026 Sprint Races Sporting Regulations 2.3.1, 2.3.2 & 2.3.3
- 1.2 **PAYMENTS:**
There is an 'early bird Entry fee' (for all four rounds & Early bird entries guarantee entry to all four rounds of the Ramadan Challenge)
Junior Cup Early Bird fee is AED 1665 per driver inc VAT
Senior Cup Early Bird fee is AED 2085 per driver inc VAT
- 1.3 All entries received after the **16th of February** will be charged as follows: **Junior Cup AED 475 per round inc of 5% VAT**
Senior Cup AED 595 per round inc of 5% VAT
- 1.4 Early bird payments are non transferable and no refund will be given if no show.
- 1.5 No refunds or credit against future races will be given on the individual entries, for late comers or no show.
- 1.6 **STARTERS:** The maximum number of entries permitted per Ramadan Challenge Round is: **36 x Seniors and 34 x Juniors**
- 1.7 **The OFFICAL NOTICE BOARD will be displayed:** Under the Canopy at the Outdoor Kartdrome
- 1.8 **Time Schedule of Events:** Timetable will be displayed on official Notice board and website.

- 2.2 **Senior Cup & Masters Format:**
Limited to **36** drivers entering

Practice & Qualifying – 8 minutes
Race 1 → (Drivers will start as per their official classified Qualifying result) **Race Laps as stipulated on timetable**
Race 2 → (Drivers will start as per official Race 1 results) "
Race 3 → (Top 6 driver's from Race2 will have their start positions reversed) "
- 3.0: **POINT SCORING:**

- 3.1: Event Point Scoring:** The Organisers will keep track of each competitor's finishing results during each event, using the points system detailed in the **2026 Dubai Kartdrome Sodi World Series (SWS) Sprint Races Sporting Regulations, Regulation 2.4.2.9**. Points from this point system will be awarded for each heat and tallied together. The Driver with the highest total of points, will be declared the **Overall Winner of the day**.

Tie On Points during a Race Event:

- Should there be a situation where competitors are equal on points, then the classification will be decided by the Driver who had the highest finishings from any of the races during the event.
- In the event there is still a draw, the result will be decided as per the official classified result from qualifying.

- 3.2: SWS World Ranking Points:** The Ramadan Challenge will count towards the SWS World Rankings and those drivers registered with the SWS World Series; their points will be allocated as per the point scoring system defined by the SodiWSeries regulations.

****For the Junior Cup, TWO sets of SWS points and for the Senior Sprint Cup & Masters, THREE sets of SWS points will be forwarded to the official SWS Championship, as per the official classified results from each of the races.***

- 3.3: Ramadan Championship Points:** Each Ramadan Challenge competitor will score "Ramadan Championship Points", to determine the overall Championship Ranking after 4 rounds. These points are listed in **SR. 3.4**

- 3.5** There will be an additional **Ramadan Championship points** for the driver setting **Pole Position** during **Qualifying** and the **Fastest Lap** on the night, for both Junior Cup and Seniors, in all four Rounds.

3.6 Tie On Points at the conclusion of the Ramadan Challenge

- In the case of 2 drivers are having the same number of Championship points, they will be separated with regards to the following elements:
Number of 1st places, 2nd places, 3rd places and so as per rounds .
Number of pole positions, 2nd places, 3rd places and so on in qualifying sessions .
Result of the last race.

4.0: PRIZES:

- 4.1 **The 2026 Junior Ramadan Challenge Champion** – will receive a **free hire of a race kart and team support** into a round of the DAMC during the 2026 season courtesy of **GGM (George Gibbons Motorsport)**. Please refer to the Terms and Conditions mention in **Regulation 5**.
- 4.2 **The 2026 Senior Ramadan Challenge Champion** – will receive a Free test day in either an IAME or Rotax kart supplied by GGM.

5.0 TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PRIZES :

- 5.1: Should any prize winner entitled one of the prizes awarded not wish to utilize them, they are to inform Dubai Autodrome Management, who will award the said prize to the next highest competitor.
- 5.2: Should any of the prizes be a fully funded race meeting from one of our sponsors, the Prize winner must have booked their race weekend with GGM mentioned, by **March 31st 2026**, Dubai Autodrome Management, reserve the right to award the said prize to the next highest competitor.
- 5.3: Should any Prize Winners have booked their race weekend with GGM, but cancel it or not turn up – Prize becomes automatically null and void. Dubai Autodrome Management, reserve the right to award the said prize to the next highest competitor.
