**Subject: Bulletin #5- Endurance General Regulations V3**

Dear Team Managers, Captains, and Drivers,

We have shared several bulletins over the past few days, in addition to the ones prior to Round 1.

To simplify and streamline all updates for the remainder of the season in the one point of reference, we have reflected all of these and updated the **Dubai Kartdrome Endurance General Regulations to V3**, where all changes have been consolidated.

For reference, the below have since updated within the Sporting Regulations:

- Revised Endurance Championship Calendar, postponing R2 & R3 dates.
- **Regulation 9d- Driver Weight & Arm Badge Compliance**
- **Appendix 1- Penalty 8- Bumping/Contact during qualifying**
- **Appendix 1- Penalty 30- Vaping or Smoking within the venue**
- Please note that these regulations are applied to the Trophy 6HR Endurance as well as the Endurance Championship 2026- Round 2, 3 & 4.
- **Regulation 2g. – New introduction of the Master's Category - A team is eligible to participate in the Master's Category only if:**

The minimum age for participation in the Master's Category is 25 years.

**NOTE: Correction to Bulletin #3 - All drivers have an individual weight of 95 kg or above, and Drivers weighing less than 95 kg are permitted to add ballast to their karts to meet the minimum required weight for this category. Average weight will not be considered as criteria for this class.**

Master Teams will still continue to receive 'bonus laps' as detailed in Regulation 13b and will be classified overall as well as in this category. However, If there are fewer than five (5) teams are participating in the Master's Category, only one trophy will be awarded to the highest-placed team. 5 Teams or more and we will award the top 3 teams trophies.

Drivers in the Master's Category will be issued a yellow Driver ID badge to distinguish them from other categories. "Masters" will also be displayed next to their team name on the timing screen.

We look forward to your active participation.
