

DAMC CUP 2025 - 2026

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS



DUBAI KARTDROME will organise DAMC KARTING CUP 2025/26 – ROUND 6 & 7 race event for karts in partnership with AL AIN RACEWAY KART CLUB under permit number EMSO – 2026 - using Dubai Kartdrome Circuit on 1st May – 3rd May 2026.

The final text of these Supplementary Regulations shall be the English version, which will be used in the case of any dispute arising as to their interpretation. Headings in this document are for ease of reference only and do not form part of these Supplementary Regulations.

ORGANISATION:

The Series and its events shall be run in accordance with the requirements of EMSO (incorporating the FIA International Sporting Code and its appendices, the FIA and CIK-FIA official Bulletins, the General Prescriptions applicable to CIK-FIA Karting International Events, CIK-FIA Sporting Regulations 2025, CIK-FIA Technical Regulations 2025, the UAE RMC Technical Regulations 2025/26, the UAE RMC Sporting Regulations 2025/26 and these Supplementary Regulations. All the parties concerned (FIA, CIK-FIA, EMSO Al Ain Raceway, Dubai Kartdrome and entrants) undertake to apply and observe the rules governing these race events.

ENTRIES AND CATEGORIES:

The entry fee per driver is AED 850 per round (Advance Payment deadline 24th April 2026) and AED 1060 (After the Deadline).

CLASSES:

- Micro MAX and equivalent
- Mini MAX and equivalent
- Junior MAX and equivalent
- MAX and equivalent
- DD2 & DD2 Masters and equivalent

VENUE REQUIREMENT

It is absolutely forbidden to disrupt the paddock, car park or venue ground surfaces in any way by marking, drilling, staining etc.
It is required that all competitors comply with instructions issued by representatives of the venue as well as the organisation.

A Floor Mat or covering of minimum size 1.5 x 2 m is mandatory for each competitor. In order to eliminate staining/ marking of the Pit area.

No VAPING inside the briefing area.

The use of scooters is strictly prohibited within the venue, including the paddock and reception areas. Any scooters found in these areas will be confiscated, and a release fee of AED 200 will apply.

ELIGIBLE COMPETITORS:

All competitors must be holders of a current, valid and relevant racing licence which must be presented at signing on for examination. Licence permissions must be in line with DAMC Sporting Regulations 2025-2026 section 2.3

CIRCUIT: Dubai Kartdrome
Length: 1240 metres
Direction of the track: Clockwise
Side of the pole position: Right

RACE FORMAT:

Qualifying: 5 Minutes
Heats (Laps): Mic 06 / Min 06 / Jnr 07 / MAX 08 / DD2 08
Final (Laps): Mic 08 / Min 08 / Jnr 09 / MAX 10 / DD2 10

All competitors must leave the Pre-Grid at the time of the green flag and complete a minimum of ONE TIMED lap (excluding warm up and cool down laps). Once a driver enters the Pit Lane their session is deemed to be over. The result of this session will determine the starting positions for the 2 Heats in terms of overall single best lap time classification.

TRANSPONDERS:

All drivers require their own transponder. Transponders are mandatory for official practice and participants will not be permitted to practice without them. Those without can procure one on the day there will be a hire fee of AED 105 per day payable to Dubai Kartdrome at their reception area. Loss or damage will be charged in full. Alternatively you may wish to purchase your own transponder. Limited numbers are available on a first-come, first-served basis at a cost of AED 1680. It will be mandatory for drivers to have completed their race entry, signed in, collected and installed their transponder on their kart prior to the warm up. The organiser cannot be responsible for any competitor losing his/her transponder on the track or entering the race without a transponder on his/her kart. In that situation the competitor will not be classified.

TIME SCHEDULE OF EVENT:

Race event starts Friday 1st May 2026 at 0730hrs and finishes 3rd May at 1250hrs. A detailed time schedule will be displayed on the official Notice Board.

BRIEFING:

To be held at Dubai Kartdrome reception area. The presence of all concerned Entrants and Drivers is mandatory. Non-attendance of drivers/entrants will incur a fine of AED 500 and/or prohibition from the race meeting while latecomers will be fined AED 250. It is the driver's/entrant's duty to enquire about time and place of the briefing and/or consecutive briefings. Drivers who are under 18 years of age must be accompanied by the Parent / Guardian who countersigned the signing on paperwork and must be present in the Briefing. Time and location will be posted on official Notice Board and available from Reception. [See 2.5.3 DAMC CUP Sporting Regulations 2025-2026]

NOTICE BOARD:

The official noticeboard is the digital noticeboard. An unofficial noticeboard will also be available outside race control.

AWARDS:

The first three drivers of each category in the Finals will receive a trophy subject to DAMC CUP Sporting Regulations 2025/26. The organisers reserve the right to proceed with the awards presentation regardless of the status of any appeals/protests.

PROTEST AND APPEALS:

The Clerk of the course decision is final. No Protests or Appeals will be entered into.

FUEL/OIL:

A single-source control fuel will be made available to all competitors and mixed in accordance with the prescribed regulations. This fuel will be stored in a restricted and controlled area for the duration of the event. Only this control fuel and the specified oil may be used. Kart fuel tanks must be collected and fitted to the kart in a designated area prior to accessing the Pre-Grid at the end of each session. Fuel tanks must be removed, refuelled in the designated area, using the control fuel and returned to the organisers after each on-track session. The pre-mix ratio for ROTAX engines shall be 50:1 (2% oil to fuel). Only Xeramic Synmax Fully Synthetic 2T Racing Oil, supplied exclusively by Kartdrome, is permitted.

TYRES:

Marked and scanned race tyres maximum 1 SET per round that will handed out on Friday 1st May can be used for practice on 1st May. These must be used for all sessions of the event day Saturday 2nd May and Sunday 3rd May. Race tyres will be according to the below compound.

Micro MAX and Mini MAX and equivalent on MOJO C2 tyres
Junior MAX and (and equivalent) on MOJO D2 tyres
MAX and (and equivalent) on MOJO D5 tyres
DD2 and DD2 Masters (and equivalent) on MOJO D5 tyres

GEARING AND JETTING:

Micro MAX gearing fixed at 15:71
Mini MAX gear ratio- 15:73

Main jets limited according to the below range:

Micro – 105 - 110
Mini – 110 - 118
Junior/ MAX – 118 - 130
DD2 – 128 - 140

FLAGS:

Flag signals will be given in accordance with the regulations of the UAE RMC Championship and with Appendix H of the present code.

SPECIFIC REGULATIONS:

Articles 5.3 of the UAE RMC Sporting Regulations 2025/26 are not applicable.
